11. We declare an end to the prison industrial complex and mass incarceration, even if it requires the ultimate sacrifice of our very lives.
12. We declare restorative and transformative justice as the methods for correcting and making repairs when we injure each other. We will not condemn each other for wrong doing but encourage each other to make better decisions and to repair what we break.
13. We declare that we are not free until every man, woman, girl, boy, of every race and creed is also free (free from a system of punishment, free from wage theft, free from scapegoating, free from oppression, and the forces of evil that lust to oppress).
